



PICKLEBALL

PILOT PROJECT GUIDELINES

1. The Pilot Project will begin on August 1, 2022 and continue through July 31, 2023. It will be possible to extend the pilot if determined to be necessary, prior to an owner vote, but the pilot will last no longer than July 31, 2024.
2. During the Pilot Project, any Owner Issues related to the Pilot will utilize the current 'owner issue reporting' forum to document any comments or concerns for investigation, tracking and reporting. These are communicated through the website, through emails to the General Manager, or brought forward at the Quarterly Owner Issue Forum.
3. Tennis Court #2, the far Southeast court on The Shores property, will be designated for Pickleball play. There will be no pickleball play allowed during the pilot project on Tennis Court #1 without Board approval.
4. Use of blue painter's tape to delineate pickleball court boundaries is used when lightly applied by players during the pilot. **Tape must be removed immediately by the players when play ends.**
5. The tennis net is not to be adjusted in any way during pickleball play.
6. Pickleball hours are 9:00am-5:00 pm during the Pilot period.
7. When play is concluded, the nets are dismantled, and the tennis court is returned.
8. As with tennis, court shoes are worn to play pickleball. Pickleball uses a small plastic whiffle ball, which is much lighter than a tennis ball and will do no harm to the court surface.
9. Any supplies used during the Pickleball Pilot will be donated – no expense to the AOA will be incurred.
 - a. A donated storage box is in use.
 - b. The donated net will be kept in this box near the office entry.
